Your application for intra-university transfer is to include a written statement in which you indicate your reasons for seeking transfer. Please use the space provided on the back of the application form for your statement. You will be eligible for intra-university transfer when you have met the appropriate credit hour and grade point average requirements as indicated below:

1. A student who has been in residence for **two semesters** is to have a minimum of **24 hours** and a cumulative grade point average of **1.80**.
2. A student who has been in residence for **three semesters** is to have a minimum of **39 hours** and a cumulative grade point average of **1.85**.
3. A student who has been in residence for **four semesters** is to have a minimum of **54 hours** and a cumulative grade point average of **1.90**.
